

FINAL EXAM INFO

Final exams are given in all Honors and Level II classes in English, mathematics, science, social studies, and world languages. Finals may also be administered in other courses such as health and year-long electives. All students are required to take their scheduled final exams.

Do not schedule vacations, appointments, college orientation programs, college courses, or work during scheduled exam times.

For exam security, all students must report to their scheduled exams and remain for the entire exam time. Students failing to report to or remain in a scheduled exam room will receive a zero for the exam; this could cause the student to fail the course.

Parents must contact the high school administration immediately if their student is ill and cannot attend the exam. If a student misses an exam due to an illness, a doctor's note is required, and the student must take the exam at the time/location designated by the administration.

Review and Exams June 2–8

- Final exam review will take place between June 2 and June 8. These are full days of school.
- Performance or competency-based examinations will be administered in some courses June 2 through June 7.
- Semester final exams will be administered in class over two day period on June 6 and June 7.
- Health and F&CS finals will be administered in class June 6 and June 7.
- World language listening exams will be administered in class June 6 and June 7.
- English final exams will take place on June 8, which is a full day of school.

- No collars are required on June 9 - 13. Students must be covered from the collar bone to the knee.
- No lunch will be served on exam days - June 9 through June 13.

June 14–15
